Supplement to Yu Shu in Shuihudi Bamboo Strip Manuscripts of Qin Dynasty

Abstract: Yu Shu is an important historical record retained on the bamboo strip manuscripts dated to the Qin Dynasty. Three elements of the manuscripts can be discerned, i.e. people (the tomb's owner Xi and the South Prefecture's mayor Teng), region (South Prefecture), and book (Yushu). With the analysis on the three elements, this paper focuses on the conflict between Qin law and customs of the newly occupied areas, the local officers' attitude toward the law of Qin, and its effect to the administrative system at the time.
